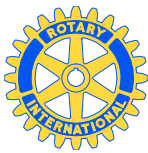

### **OZANAM**

Since 1948, Ozanam has helped thousands of children with emotional, behavioral and learning disabilities by providing residential and day treatment programs for boys and girls ages 12-18 on its main campus in south Kansas City. Also, through its Pathways Transitional Living Program, Ozanam provides shelter, counseling support and job training to young adults who are at risk of becoming homeless in Kansas City and Wichita. Ozanam also provides educational services to community school districts by offering educational consultation programs through our Behavior Intervention Support Team (BIST) to more than 300 schools throughout the Midwest. Ozanam provides services to more than 225 at-risk children each day and additionally impacts thousands of students each day through our BIST program.

### **HOPE HOUSE**

Hope House's works to break the cycle of domestic violence by providing safe refuge and supportive services that educate and empower to those affected by domestic violence.

Hope House services form a safety net of prevention, education and support for more than 10,000 victims of abuse every year. Residential and outreach are provided through two secure locations in Independence and Lee's Summit, MO. Each location features a 52 bed shelter, early childhood center, therapy space, administration offices and community training facilities.

Additionally, Hope House provides services to the community at large. These services include a confidential 24-hour crisis hotline (**816.461.HOPE [4673]**); individual, family and children's counseling and support groups; 24-hour on-call advocacy for victims in hospitals; training for law enforcement professionals and medical staff; information and advocacy during hearings and trials; and extensive educational presentations to schools, businesses and various community organizations. All Hope House services are confidential.

### **THE PLAZA ROTARY FOUNDATION**

The Kansas City Plaza Rotary Charitable Foundation was formed in 1992 and enjoys 501(c) (3) status under the Internal Revenue Code. The mission of the Foundation is to promote community betterment through the support of youth, education and the elderly. The Foundation Board is made up of the past presidents of the Plaza Rotary Club. Since the inception, the Foundation has disbursed thousands of dollars raised through the efforts of the members of the Plaza Rotary Club. Under the current policy, seventy-five percent of the net proceeds of the Jazz Cabaret are awarded to the primary and the secondary beneficiaries. The beneficiaries are selected by the members of the club with the approval of the Foundation Board. Also, each year the Foundation awards grants of approximately \$500 to \$1000 to selected organizations that submit requests and are sponsored by a club member.

All recipients of grants from the Foundation must be recognized 501(c) (3) organizations.
